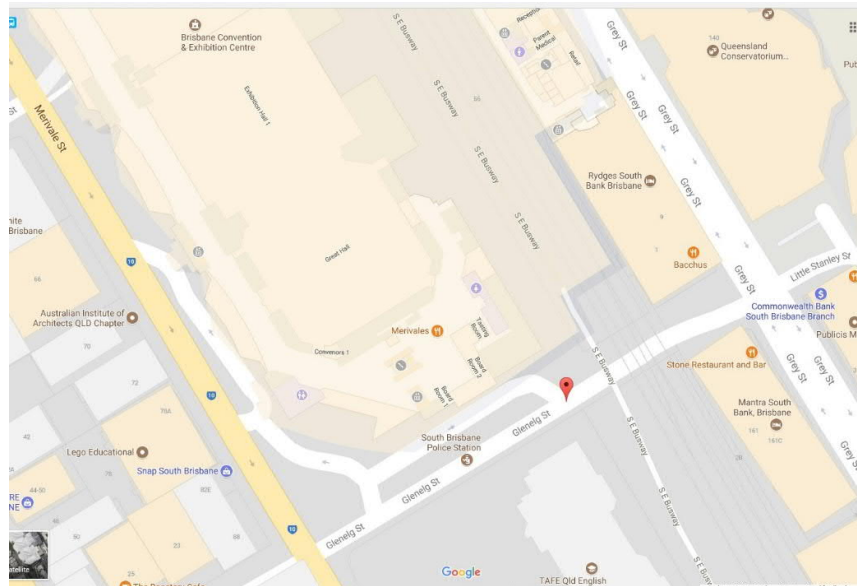


11:40 View Sir Thomas Brisbane Planetarium display
